



Gold Coast Dressage 2009 SUCCEED® Invitational Official Rules and Regulations

PURPOSE: To give back to our supporters by partnering with the Gold Coast Dressage Association

GUARANTEED PRIZE MONEY: \$1500.00 from Freedom Health, LLC

RULES:

1. Eligibility of participation:

A. The 2008 Gold Coast SUCCEED Invitational series is open to all participants in the approved shows.

B. Owner whose horse is presently on SUCCEED.

C. Length of eligibility shall be as follows:

The length of eligibility is totally dependent on the length of time of your SUCCEED purchase. For example:

If owner has purchased a 30 day supply of SUCCEED, then that owner's horse shall be eligible for 30 days from date of purchase.

If owner has purchased a 60 day supply of SUCCEED, then that owner's horse shall be eligible for 60 days from date of purchase.

NOTE: When starting a horse on SUCCEED for the first time, eligibility will be reduced by one week, to allow for double dosing the first week. e.g. if purchasing a 30 day supply, the horse will only be eligible for 21 days from date of purchase for the first month of being on the product.

D. Registration:

If you purchase your SUCCEED from Spectrum Saddle Shop or Tackeria:

You may register November 1, 2008, or later by faxing, emailing or hand-delivering your completed registration form to the retailer. Please see registration form for contact information.

If you purchase your SUCCEED from another retailer:

Submit to Sandra Edgar your completed registration form on or after November 1, 2008, along with first proof of purchase for SUCCEED

(see item E below). Contact information for Sandra Edgar is provided on the registration form.

E. Proof of purchase shall consist of the following:

If you purchase your SUCCEED from Spectrum Saddle Shop or Tackeria:

Verification shall be automatically determined by the retailer. All records of eligibility shall be kept in a database by Sandra Edgar of Freedom Health, LLC.

If you purchase your SUCCEED from another retailer:

You must submit a copy of your retail invoice showing the purchase of SUCCEED. When you register, send the invoice with your registration form. Invoices verifying continued purchases of SUCCEED must be sent monthly thereafter, to maintain eligibility. **Be sure to include the names of the owner and horse.**

2. Payout of prize money:

At the Gold Coast Annual Meeting and Awards Banquet, prizes will be awarded in each of the divisions: Training / First; Second thru Fourth; and FEI. First place prizes will be awarded to the highest placed eligible horses (i.e., horses that have been verified on SUCCEED, as determined by rule #1 above) in those divisions. First place prizes will include \$500.00 prize money, one (1) 90-day supply of SUCCEED DCP Granules, and other additional prizes (to be determined). Second place in each division shall receive one (1) 60 day supply of SUCCEED DCP Granules. Third place shall receive one (1) 30 day supply of SUCCEED DCP Granules.

Points for the competition shall be allocated as follows:

- 1st place = 10 points
- 2nd place = 8 points
- 3rd place = 6 points
- 4th place = 4 points
- 5th place = 2 points

It will be the responsibility of each rider to inform GCDA's Official Point Keeper Arnelle Liblit of any points that each horse has earned, and at which competitions they were gained. (These will be verified.) Results need to be submitted promptly after each event for points to be counted! Participants who do not purchase SUCCEED from Spectrum Saddle Shop or Tackeria may provide this information to Sandra Edgar at sedgar@freedomhealthllc.com.

Any GCDA horse show will count towards the points standings (subject to additions and/or changes throughout the year), including but not limited to the following:

3. Prize money:

There shall be Prize money donated by Freedom Health, LLC, of \$1500 (\$500 per eligible level of competition, as described in rule #2).
